I - Introduction

1.1 Overview of the B.Sc. Nursing Course

The Colleges of Nursing included in this Prospectus offer B.Sc. Nursing Degree Programme of 4-year duration as specified by Kerala University of Health Sciences, (KUHS), approved by Indian Nursing Council & Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council.

1.2 The Private Nursing College Management Association in Kerala has decided to introduce a separate selection procedure for admission of candidates in the Management Quota to the B.Sc. Nursing course as per the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its judgements dated 31st October 2002, dated 14th August 2003 and 4th January 2007.

1.3 This prospectus contains the rules and regulations for selection and admission to the seats to be filled by the Managements of Self- Financing Colleges of Nursing for the year 2016-2017.

1.4 This prospectus is subject to modification/addition/deletion as may be deemed necessary by the Association and subject to the Judgements of Honorable Courts of law.

II – Institutions and Number of Seats

2.1 No. of seats: The annual intake of each college is shown in the annexure.

2.2 (a) **All the candidates admitted shall pay the fees fixed by Government of Kerala / Fee Regulatory Committee and as approved or modified by competent authorities.**

(b) The list of institutions under the Private Nursing College Management Association in Kerala, the number of seats and other details are given in Annexure.

(c) Admission to courses in the institutions for which approval/permission has not been obtained will be subject to the approval/permission from the Nursing Council/ University/ Government.

III – Eligibility for Admission

3.1 **Academic:**

(i) Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education of Kerala or equivalent examinations recognized by any of the Universities in the State of Kerala with 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English put together are eligible for admission.

(ii) **Relaxation in marks: -**

(a) Candidates belonging to SEBC (Socially and Educationally Backward Classes) in the State of Kerala with total annual family income up to Rs.4 lakhs will have relaxation of 5% marks. The Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe candidates in the state of Kerala need only a pass in the qualifying examination.

(b) Those candidates claiming relaxation of marks shall produce necessary certificates from the authority concerned. There will be no reservation of seats for SEBC and or SC/ST candidates under Management quota.

- (iii) **Eligibility Certificates:** Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from places other than State of Kerala shall produce the Eligibility certificate from KUHS Thrissur. This should be furnished at the time of interview for admission.

3.2 **Age:**

- (i) Applicants should have completed 17 years of age on the 31st December 2016. No relaxation of the minimum age will be allowed.
- (ii) Self attested copy of relevant page of school record namely SSLC/ICSE/CBSE/ certificate showing the date of birth / copy of birth certificate should be furnished along with the application in proof of age.

IV – How to apply

- 4.1 **Issue of Application forms:** The application forms and information brochure can be obtained from any of the member colleges listed in the notification/ prospectus on payment of Rs.600/- (Rupees Six hundred only) by D.D in favour of the college / cash.

- 4.2 **Submission of Application form:** The completed application form shall be submitted to the college concerned along with copies of necessary documents.

Other enclosures:-

- (i) A self-addressed envelope (25x12 cms size) with Indian Postage stamp/stamps worth Rs.5/- affixed thereon with each set of application form.

Note:

- (a) Application not accompanied by documents in proof of claims made therein will be summarily rejected without further intimation.
- (b) Candidates are requested not to enclose original of any certificate along with the application. Self-attested photocopies need only be enclosed.

(ii) Important

- (a) Documents/Certificates furnished after submission of the application will not be entertained under any circumstances.
- (b) No opportunity will be given to incorporate any details or document after the submission of the application except for those whose results are not declared before the last date of the submission of application.

V Preparation of Merit List

5.1 **Merit list:**

- (a) Out of 50% management seats 35% seats will be filled by managements from among the applications received by the member college on the basis of merit list prepared based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination in the core subjects.

- (b) Out of 50% management seats 15% NRI seats shall be filled up from qualified students as per G.O (MS) No.243/2014/HRFWD dated 6.08.2014 of Govt. of Kerala. The documents shall be submitted at the time of admission. Belated submission of document will not be accepted.
- 5.2 **Resolution of tie while ranking:** In the case of a tie in the total marks, the marks in Biology will count. If there is still a tie the marks in Chemistry and Physics will be counted. If a tie still exists, the age of the candidate will be taken into account, the elder will be preferred to the younger.
- 5.3 **Validity of the merit list:** The published merit list will be valid till 31-10-2016 or the date up to which the merit list shall be kept alive in terms of instruction/direction of competent authority.
- 5.4 Inclusion in the merit list will not entitle the applicant eligible for admission to the course, unless the applicant satisfy the rules regarding the eligibility for admission and other conditions as laid down in the Prospectus.
- 5.5 Furnishing of false information/particulars would result in the forfeiture of the candidature as well as cancellation of admission to the course, and in addition, will attract the relevant provisions of criminal law of the land.

VI – Selection Procedure

- 6.1 **Selection procedure by individual colleges:** Selection of the candidate will be done by each college from among the candidates who have applied in the college based on the marks obtained in the optional subjects (Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English) secured in the qualifying examination. Call letter for interview will be sent to each candidate from the college concerned.
- 6.2 **Community Quota:** The selection of candidates by managements of minority community will be based on the specific directive of Hon'ble Supreme Court. (Percentage of seats reserved for minority community is shown in Annexure). All right of claim for eligibility relaxation or community claim shall be sustained with the required documents at the time of submission of application. No documents submitted thereafter shall be considered for the approval of admission.

VII Admission & Payment of Fees

- 7.1 The selected candidates will be informed about the date and time of admission.
- 7.2 The students shall pay all fees of the 1st year of the course at the time of admission which will not be refunded. Fee stipulated by the Fee Regulatory Committee/Govt. of Kerala is as follows: Tuition fee- Rs. 55000, Special fee -Rs. 15000, Caution Deposit (refundable) Rs.10000 and other fees due to statutory bodies (KUHS, KN &MC & INC) as and when notified.

The fee payable by the NRI candidates will be the same as the other candidates. But they will also have to pay to the college a maximum of US \$ 2000 or equivalent at the time of admission.

- 7.3 **If any candidate discontinues the course, after closing of admission as notified by the, the candidate has to pay the full fee of the remaining course (4 yrs.). Transfer Certificate will be issued only after payment of the above amount. Also Legal proceedings will be initiated against student/parent for realization of full amount of fees.**

VIII - Special Instructions

- a. Ragging: Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in all member colleges. All the member colleges are committed to abolish ragging in their campuses. Hence any student who indulges in any form of ragging will be subjected to penal action as per provisions of law. Also the student will be expelled from the college as detailed in the law concerned and as per Honorable Supreme Court of India directions in this regard.
- b. Use of Mobile Phone: Use of Mobile Phone by students are not allowed in the campuses and hostels of any member colleges of association. Any violation of this prohibition will lead to stringent disciplinary action by the college authorities.
- c. Any other items not specifically covered in this prospectus will be decided by the undersigned, and his decision shall be final.
